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# COUNCIL

It is a group of elected officials who represent the interests of the local community. They make decisions and set policies for the area they govern. The council members are responsible for making important choices such as passing laws, approving budgets, and implementing services.

The council may decide to allocate funds for building a new park in the neighborhood or to implement new traffic regulations in the town.

# Town hall

It refers to the physical building where local government officials, including the council members, carry out their administrative duties and hold public meetings. The town hall is often the place where residents can access government services, seek assistance, and participate in public discussions.

Residents may visit the town hall to obtain permits for construction projects or register to vote.





## In summary...

At the town hall meeting, the council discussed the budget allocation for public schools in the community.

In this example, 'town hall' refers to the physical building where the council members gather for a meeting, and 'council' refers to the group of elected officials who are discussing and making decisions about the budget.

The council members held a meeting at the town hall to address residents' concerns about noise pollution.

Here, 'council' refers to the elected officials who are convening a meeting, and 'town hall' refers to the location where the meeting takes place, providing a platform for residents to express their concerns about noise pollution.

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# polite

'Polite' refers to behavior that follows social conventions and shows respect and consideration for others. It relates to manners, courtesy, and appropriate conduct in social interactions.

'He always greets everyone with a polite smile and a kind word.'

'She thanked her host for the dinner and complimented the delicious food.'

# educated

'Educated' refers to a person who has acquired knowledge, typically through formal education or learning. It implies being well-informed, knowledgeable, and having intellectual capabilities.

'He is a highly educated individual with multiple degrees.'

'She has received an excellent education from prestigious institutions.'

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## bus

It is a general term that refers to a large motor vehicle designed to transport passengers. Buses are commonly used for public transportation systems, school transportation, and city or intercity travel. They typically have multiple doors, seating arrangements, and standing areas. Buses are often used for shorter distances and make frequent stops.

## coach

It is a more specific type of bus that is typically associated with long-distance travel and luxury transportation. Coaches are designed for comfort and offer amenities such as reclining seats, air conditioning, onboard restrooms, and entertainment systems. They are commonly used for intercity travel, tours, and charter services.

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## only

It is an adverb that means 'solamente' or 'exclusivamente'. It shows that there is no other option or possibility.

- I only drink water. (Solo bebo agua).
- She is my only sister. (Ella es mi única hermana).

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## alone

It is an adjective that means 'solo' in the sense of being without any other person. It describes a state of being, not a feeling.

- I like to be alone sometimes. (Me gusta estar solo a veces).
- He lives alone in a big house. (Él vive solo en una casa grande).

## Lonely

Lonely is also an adjective, but it means 'solo' in the sense of feeling sad or isolated. It describes an emotion, not a situation.

- She feels lonely since her husband died. (Ella se siente sola desde que su marido murió).
- This is a lonely place, there are no people around. (Este es un lugar solitario, no hay gente alrededor).





## In summary...

- As you can see, the word alone indicates that we are not with anyone else; lonely indicates that we are unhappy because of that; and only indicates that there is nothing more than that.

She was the only one left alone in the empty house, feeling lonely and longing for companionship.

'Only': It emphasizes that out of all the people who were present before, she was the sole remaining individual.

'Alone': It describes her state of being without any company or others around her.

'Lonely': It expresses her emotional state of feeling isolated, lacking companionship, and experiencing a sense of sadness or longing.

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# receipt

A receipt is a document or proof of purchase that shows the details of a transaction, such as the items bought, their prices, and the total amount paid. It is typically given to the customer by a seller or merchant after a purchase is made. In Spanish, 'receipt' is translated as 'recibo' or 'factura.'

# recipe

A recipe is a set of instructions or a guide that outlines the ingredients and steps required to prepare a particular dish or drink. It provides guidance on cooking or baking procedures, quantities, and cooking times. In Spanish, 'recipe' is translated as 'receta.'
