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QUESTION TAGS

Los question tags son unas "coletillas" en forma de pregunta que se colocan al final de una oración para comprobar que la información que hemos dicho es correcta.

Trabajas el sábado, ¿no?

La tienda no abre hoy, ¿verdad?

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Pero, ¿cómo se forman?

Su estructura es:

AUXILIAR + **SUJETO** + ?

- el **AUXILIAR** depende del tiempo de la oración.

*He **works** in a bank, **doesn't** he?*

- el **SUJETO** es el mismo que en la oración.

***Hannah** studied in Rome, didn't **she**?*

- si la oración es afirmativa, el auxiliar será negativo.

*She **is** a teacher, **isn't** she?*

- si la oración es negativa, el auxiliar será afirmativo.

*Laura **hasn't** arrived yet, **has** she?*

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AUXILIARES

● Verb to be: "be" en el mismo tiempo

He *is* a nurse, *isn't* he?

You *weren't* happy, *were* you?

● Present Simple: do/does

She *plays* the piano, *doesn't* she?

You *don't like* fish, *do* you?

● Past Simple: did

She *worked* in a bank, *didn't* she?

John *didn't go* to the concert, *did* he?

● Present Perfect: have/has

They *have just finished* the exam, *haven't* they?

Eva *hasn't been* abroad recently, *has* she?

● Past Perfect: had

They *had been* to Italy before, *hadn't* they?

Jordi *hadn't eaten* insects before, *had* he?

● Future Simple: will

It *will rain* tomorrow, *won't* it?

Lara *won't pass* the test, *will* she?

● Modals: can/should/must/etc...

Your brother *can speak* German, *can't* he?

They *shouldn't eat* so much fat, *should* they?

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IRREGULARES

Cuidado, hay algunas construcciones que no siguen estas reglas:

I am ..., aren't I?

I am lost, aren't I?

Let's ..., shall we?

Let's do it again, shall we?

Imperativos ..., will you?

Call me later, will you?
